## **INK OUT**

INK OUT is the spotting product of choice for the general removal of most ink and many oily-type stains (crayon, grease, tar). It has direct application on the spotting board, allowing for minimal product usage and the ability to remove stains without costly and time-consuming recleaning.



## Directions

Fabrics:

- 1. Before spotting unfamiliar material, always test a seam inside of the garment for the colorfastness of the dye.
- 2. Sparingly apply INK OUT directly on the stain and tamp with a brush or work lightly with a bone scraper until the stain disperses. It may be helpful to place a piece of terry behind the garment to soak up any fugitive ink.
- 3. Rinse thoroughly using cold water (distilled water if the material is the type that will water spot) and vacuum the garment.
- 4. To protect the color and to prevent the stain from setting, do not rinse with steam. Once the stain is completely gone, you may feather dry with an air gun.
- 5. If the stain is not entirely removed or slow to disperse, repeat the above process before using an air gun to dry.
- 6. For heavy deposits of ink, apply INK OUT liberally and absorb with a blotter or Turkish towel to prevent ink from spreading while working with a brush or bone scraper.
